We've designed and are delivering a state of the specialist autistic centre in Blackburn.

We've Secured **£13.8m** of funding to regenerate the former Swan Hunter Shipyard to a new business park.

### Blackburn & Darwen

Our first place-based partnership in local government has delivered key schemes such as the design and project management for Pennine Reach (a £45m public transport investment scheme connecting Pennine Lancashire), the design and installation of LED street lighting across Blackburn with Darwen and highway design and project management of Blackburn's Freckleton Street link road.

The partnership has also created over 1500 jobs.

### North Tyneside

Capita's Partnership with North Tyneside Council, has delivered on key projects such as flood alleviation works, public realm improvements at the coast and consultation on the Draft Local Plan.

Other achievements include helping the local authority secure more than **£20million** in external funding for major road improvement schemes and rationalising the industrial estates portfolio, enabling a **£1million** investment in the remaining estates.

The Partnership has led to income/savings of over **£7million**.

We have designed the A556 major strategic highways route between South Manchester and Northern Cheshire.

Through our Entrust partnership, 81% of schools have improved and are now rated as good or outstanding by Ofsted, an increase of 16 percentage points since 2012.

Our channel shift programme with Sheffield City Council won the 'excellence in innovation' award at the ITRV Performance awards.

### Salford - Urban Vision
